**MINUTES OF THE STATE SEED PRICING COMMITTEE (SSPC) MEETING HELD ON 23.03.2017 AT 3.30 PM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF AGRICULTURE & FARMERS' EMPOWERMENT DEPARTMENT FOR FINALIZATION OF COST STRUCTURE OF DIFFERENT AGRICULTURAL SEEDS AND HORTICULTURAL PLANTING MATERIALS TO BE SUPPLIED DURING KHARIF-2017.**

A meeting of the State Seed Pricing Committee was held on 23.03.2017 at 3.30 PM under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government in the Conference Hall of Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment Department to finalize the cost structure of different Agricultural seeds and Horticultural planting materials to be supplied during Kharif-2017. The list of participants present in the meeting is furnished at Annexure-1.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members. He asked the D.A. & F.P.(O) and M.D, OSSC about the seed production programme and action taken for smooth supply of different certified seeds during Kharif-2017. He stated that farmers usually exercise their own choice while purchasing seeds. There will be competition between private seed producers and OSSC. He emphasized on quality seed production through OSSC so that farmers can prefer the seeds supplied by the Govt. agencies. M.D., OSSC informed about the quantity of different varieties of paddy seeds produced and procured by their agency.

Various issues discussed in the meeting are as follows:-

1. Finalization of cost structure, all-in-cost price & subsidy to be provided for supply of different certified agricultural seeds to the farmers:

Discussion was made in respect of procurement price suggested by D.A. & F.P.(O) with respect to proposed price submitted by OSSC Ltd. Further, the all-in-cost price & amount of subsidy to be provided to the farmers through DBT for supply of certified seeds like Paddy, Ragi, Moong, Biri, Arhar, Groundnut, Til, Niger, Jute & Dhanicha were also discussed. Discussion was also made with respect to seed production of Ragi & other millets through WASSAN in the selected districts under the State Plan scheme "Special Programme for Millets in the Tribal areas". Other issues like purchase of different seeds & Horticultural planting material through ATMA & NAM programme as well as practices to be adopted by the Govt. farms, cost of cultivation were also discussed.

2. Finalization of production cost and sale rate of different Horticultural planting materials produced in Govt farms and nurseries for 2017-18:

The requirement of Quality Planting Materials (QPM) for different fruit and plantation crops for the year 2017-18 and the availability in different farms as well as their production cost, procurement cost and all-in cost were discussed.

3. Post- facto approval of cost of budded rose plants procured from RPRC during 2016-17:

The cost structure proposed by Director of Horticulture, Odisha was discussed. Director of Horticulture, Odisha has utilized 33363 nos. rose budded plants from RPRC. It was earlier allowed for procurement of budded rose plants @ cost of Rs.18/- per plant and release of subsidy in to the farmers' account through DBT with Post- facto approval of SSSC.

4. Approval of cost structure of seed potato for the year 2017-18.

Director of Horticulture, Odisha has selected the seed potato suppliers for 2017-18 through EOI along with their offered prices. But it was observed that the offered prices appear to be too high than the prevailing market price.

5. Ginger and Turmeric seed materials to be procured from inside state through KASAM during 2016-17:

The spices programme under NHM, assistance pattern, eligible beneficiaries, previous year programme and achievement as well as its necessity and impact was discussed in the meeting.

6. Subsidized sale of planting materials:


Promotion of back yard plantation through subsidized sale of planting materials was also discussed.

After a threadbare discussion, the following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

















1. The procurement price of different certified seeds like Paddy, Ragi, Arhar, Groundnut, Til, Niger, Jute & Dhanicha were approved in the meeting and furnished at Annexure-2. The weighted average of procurement price for different paddy seeds is furnished at Annexure-3.
2. The procurement price along with all-in-cost price & subsidy to be provided to the farmers through DBT has also been approved by the committee details of which are furnished at Annexure-4.
3. Procurement of Til & Niger seeds produced in the Govt. farms will be made at the price @ 25% more than the minimum support price (MSP).
4. Seeds & Horticultural planting materials including fertilizers, micronutrients, and pesticides purchased in the ATMA & NHM programmes are to be reflected in the website. Instructions shall be issued by the Director of Horticulture, Odisha to field officials. Any deviation shall be seriously viewed.
5. Modern practices and farm mechanization are to be adopted in the Govt. Farms. Productivity and production should be as per the benchmarks expected from such

- model farms. The person in-charge of farms should be held accountable for the same. D.A. & F.P.(O) may issue instructions along with benchmarking parameters.
6. The quality planting materials (QPM) available in departmental farms will be utilized first. The production cost, procurement cost and all-in-cost for 2017-18 will remain the same as decided in the SSPC meeting held on 11.12.2015 which is furnished at Annexure-5.
  7. The procurement cost of Rs.18/- per plant in case of budded rose plants procured from RPRC during 2016-17 was approved.
  8. As the offered price of seed potatoes is found to be high like last year, the selected agencies will sale their seed potatoes through the cold store owners directly to the farmers and the farmers will get the subsidy through DBT for which Director of Horticulture, Odisha will develop an online system / platform. However, Director of Horticulture, Odisha will ensure quality of the seed potatoes before sale to the farmers. Further, the foundation seeds produced by OSSC will be sold out to the interested farmers / cold store owners for further multiplication @Rs.1600/- per quintal. The farmers utilizing seed potatoes of OSSC will also avail subsidy as per norm through DBT over and above this price.
  9. The programme for procurement of Ginger and Turmeric seed materials from inside state through KASAM during 2017-18 has been approved in the Committee. However, Director of Horticulture will submit a proposal for introduction of new varieties developed by OUAT / other SAUs with quality paramerers like curcumin content of turmeric etc. involving KVKs for the next year. The procurement cost and all-in- cost price of Ginger and Turmeric seed materials are furnished at Annexure-6.
  10. The committee approved the subsidized sale of planting materials, which is furnished at Annexure-7. However, Director of Horticulture, Odisha will ensure approval of beneficiaries list in the GPs and up load the beneficiaries list in the website.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
